

Meaning of "Theory"

- The word 'theory' comes from the Latin word "theoria", in turn adopted from the Greek word "theoros", which means 'spectator'.
- Theory is as a conception or mental scheme of something to be done, or of the method of doing it, and a systematic statement of rules or principles to be followed.
- Theory is a supposition or a system of ideas intended to explain something, especially one based on general principles independent of the thing to be explained.



 Theories are varied, such as scientific, humanistic, mathematical, social, psychological, ...etc.

Example: Darwin's theory of evolution, Gestalt theory, Psychoanalysis theory, Relativity theory.....

The attention and awareness of the importance of the word "Theory" has increased since the 18th century, and specially in the second half of the 20th century.

Why do we study theory?

 Theory shows us the path that our ideas lead to. It helps us reach our goals and saves time, money and thinking. To get to the result we seek; theorizing tries to free us from trial and error, and give us suggested opinions or rules. Good practice depends on the correct understanding of theory.

Architectural Theory

- Architectural theory is considered to be the act of thinking, discussing, or most importantly writing about architecture.
- When we study architectural theory, we find different levels of knowledge and writings. It could be a solid clear "Theory" that has many applications and rules, or we can see "Thoughts" that are individual opinions. We can observe discussions and arguments to prove or disprove a point of view. The theorist succeeds when he is able to convince people by his clear, logical opinions.

Theorists: Marcus **Vitruvius** Pollio The author of "De architectura"


(The Ten Books on Architecture)




The subjects of Vitruvius Ten Books are:

Landscape architecture, Construction materials, Temples, Public places, Private dwellings, Finishes and colors, Water supply, Sundials and clocks, Mechanical engineering.

Vitruvius suggested the five fundamental principles of design: (Order, Eurhythmy, Symmetry, Propriety and Economy).

- Accumulation of experience led to the accuracy, high quality, and beauty of products.










- Craftsmanship is an inherited knowledge and practice, from fathers to sons, and from masters to workers.




To master a craft there must be a coordination between these three parts...

 The ability to transcend traditional ideas, patterns, or relationships and to initiate meaningful new ideas, forms, or interpretations.




